## **Progress:**

IPC has been working with the Arboretum for several years. The last few visits have involved educational training sessions conducted by IPC and maintenance treatments to sites previously treated. With the unique diversity of plants present at the National Arboretum, IPC had to be especially careful to offer selective control techniques.



Viburnum dilatatum is one of the multistemmed species IPC is cutting and treating at the National Arboretum. This plant is located in close proximity to native varieties that our crews must be careful not to disturb. Most cutting and treating was accomplished during the fall and winter months. This species was held back so that the foliage would be out and easier to identify in the late spring.
