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Invasive Species in America

Creation of Invasive Species

- Free Living Exotic Species
- Native Species Remove Top Predators

Uncontrolled Introductions

- 50,000 Introduced Species and Varieties
- 1,500+ Introduced Invasive Plants

Impacts on Human Health

■ Spread of Disease; Injury, Stings

Ecological Impacts

- Outcompete / Hybridize with Natives
- Destroy Habitat (Gypsy Moth)
- Alter Ecosystems (Melaleuca in FL)
- Alter Fire Cycles (Cheatgrass in the West)
- #2 Threat to Endangered Species (400/958 spp.)

■ Economic Impacts


- Food and Fiber Production
- Increased Losses and Control Costs (\$150 Billion)
- Increased Cost of Government Programs













Ecological Impacts of IVS.

- Threaten Endangered Species
- Crowd out Natives
- Compete with Natives for Resources, Space, Light
- Disrupt Trophic Level Relationships
- Increase Disturbance
 Regimes that Natives are
 not Adapted to (e.g.,
 Wildfires)
- Hybridize with Natives
- Cause Habitat Loss

Africa (Aquatic Weed Control): \$US60 Million


Economic Impacts of IVS.

Direct Losses

- Crop Losses (India 20% Per Year)
- Loss of Exports
 - Karnal Bunt of Wheat
- Loss of Pasture Productivity
 - Cogongrass
- Loss of Fisheries
 - Nile Perch

Indirect Losses

- Flooding (Water Hyacinth)
- Landslides (Miconia)
- Damage to Dams (Nutria)
- Increased Wildfires (Cheatgrass)
- Loss of Tourism (Spotted Knapweed)

Diseases

- 1999 West Nile Virus -USA
 - 9,862 People Infected
 - 264 People Died
- 2003 SARS in China
- \$17 Billion Tourism Losses
